What is a Home Team?

Home Teams are the small group ministry for adults at Northway Church. Groups consist of 6-16 people and meet at a time and place of their own choosing. Most meet in homes, but some meet on the campus of Northway. In this booklet you will see there are home teams for every age and stage of life. It's a great way to build new friendships while studying the Bible in a relaxed and casual environment.



Why should I join a Home Team?

There are two primary reasons for joining a home team:

1—To study and discuss the Bible

Bible study is the center piece of all Home Team sessions. This small-group setting allows for interaction and discussion of Biblical truths and concepts with a group of like-minded people so that we can better apply these principles to our lives.

2—To experience community through new relationships

Everyone desires to belong! In a Home Team, you will make new friends and, in some cases, these may become the people you'll do life with; the ones you'll call on in a time of need. In the process you'll experience the truth of what we like to say: *"Life is better connected!"*

Unless otherwise noted, Home Teams will be discussing the sermon series presented by Pastor Kevin. Entitled “Abraham: A Faith for All Seasons,” this study will take a deeper look at one of the heroes of our faith. While Abraham demonstrated great examples of faith, he also had seasons where he either tried to help God out or failed to trust His promises. Throughout this session you will see Abraham was a person just like us, so we are just as capable to live out a great faith!

Each participant will receive a free workbook which will include insight from Pastor Kevin, space for sermon notes, and discussion questions. You can receive your workbook at church or in your Home Team.

The idea is simple! You already have friends with whom you feel comfortable and trust. So, invite three friends or couples to join you and “Connect 4” to create a new group. (Of course, your group can have as many or as few as you prefer.) If you form a group, let us know at church and we will come alongside to help you every step of the way. FAQ'S

What are the dates for the Winter semester?

Groups will begin the week of January 29 and conclude the week of April 16. Having specific dates allows you to try out a Home Team without making a long term commitment. However, most who join a group continue with the group for multiple semesters!

How often does a group meet?

Each group sets their own schedule and may meet weekly, bi-weekly, or three times a month.

What's a group meeting like?

Most groups serve refreshments or a meal at the front end of their time together, then enter into their Bible study. Sessions are always very casual and conversational in nature, with the leader facilitating discussion.

How long are group meetings?

Most groups meet about 90 minutes including social time. Some meet longer, some shorter; it all depends on the needs of the group.

What happens after I sign up?

When you sign up, our leadership team will assign you to one of your choices as quickly as possible. The leader of your Home Team will then contact you with all the specific information about your group.

What if I don't see a group that fits my interest or schedule?

Grab a few friends and create a new group! We'll help you get started with all the materials you'll need. Otherwise, contact Phil Anderson, our Connections Pastor, as he may be able to direct you to an existing Home Team or a new group that is being formed. What if I'm already in a group?

That's great! We just don't want to assume each person is returning, so all we ask is that you sign up for your group again through this registration process or by contacting your group leader directly. This also ensures that each person is committed to the group for this semester.

WHAT ABOUT CHILDCARE?

Sunday evenings

Childcare will be provided most Sunday evenings at the church. Pre-registration is required. Your group leader will provide the link.

Childcare Reimbursement Plan

To assist our families, we offer a partial reimbursement of your childcare expenses. Each couple or group can arrange their own childcare and pay the sitter(s) the market rate. At the end of the month, each couple or group can submit a reimbursement form to subsidize their expenses! These forms are available on the Home Team page of our church website.
